## PENNSYLVANIA ODYSSEY OF THE MIND

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### **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

#### Who is eligible?

- New memberships
- Memberships that have not had a team compete at a regional tournament the past five years. If your membership had a team compete in 2014 and have not competed since, you are eligible!

#### What is the deadline?

The deadline to submit an application is December 1. Grant recipients will be announced on a rolling basis as applications are received. The grants will be awarded at the discretion of Creativity Unlimited in Pennsylvania, the 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that administers Odyssey of the Mind in Pennsylvania.

#### What is covered by the grants?

- 1. Membership registration with Creative Competitions Inc. (starting at \$135)
- 2. Regional fees (vary depending on region, usually around \$100)
- 3. State tournament fees (if the team advances to State Finals, usually about \$100)
- 4. Cost limit of the problem(s) solved (ranges from \$125 to \$145 depending on the problem)
- 5. A one-time \$50 stipend for tools and additional supplies

The final amount will vary depending on the number of teams, the problem(s) solved by the team(s), and if the team(s) advance to State Finals.

#### What is not covered by the grants?

Because the goal is to increase participation, the grants will only cover teams with unique team members, meaning an individual student cannot compete on multiple teams covered by a grant. Any additional expenses not listed above will not be covered by the grants. This includes transportation costs and other accommodations to attend a regional tournament or State Finals. Finally, World Finals costs will not be covered by our grants if your team advances to that level.

#### What other resources are provided to help a new team?

Each of our regions offers a free coaches' training in the fall, and we encourage you to attend! You will also be paired with one of our long-time volunteers. Your OMer buddy will answer any questions you may have as a coach about how the Odyssey of the Mind program works and what to expect on tournament day.

#### How are the grants funded?

The grants are all donor-funded by generous members of the PA Odyssey of the Mind community who want to provide access to our creative problem-solving program to as many children as possible. Thank you to our donors for your support!
