

## **Escape vroOM**

Odyssey teams take their problem-solving skills inside a box as they create a performance that includes one or more team-created vehicles that will help a group of characters escape an unusual room. The vehicle will travel to areas within the room and complete tasks. Each time it completes a task it will release a "clue" that the group will use in the next area to release the next clue, and so on. When the vehicle performs the final task, it will reveal a final clue that allows the group to escape the room and they discover the mystery behind the room!

## PROBLEM 2: TECHNICAL

## **Odyssey ReOMvention**

While no one knows what the future holds, it's likely OMers will have an important role in it! To prove just that, teams will present a performance that identifies an original threat to the environment that self-replicates until a team-created technical reOMvention removes the threat. This award epitomizes the spirit of Odyssey of the Mind. Presented to teams or individuals exhibiting exceptional creativity, the Ranatra Fusca encourages creative thinking and risk-taking. A successful solution is not criterion for winning.

The name has a special meaning. Odyssey was born from a college class taught by founder Dr. Sam Micklus. He had students create flotation devices to cross a pond. One student made a water-strider-like contraption, which couldn't solve the problem because of its inability to maintain balance. However, the idea was exceptionally creative, and the Ranatra Fusca Award, named after the species of a water-striding insect, was born.



#### **OMER's Award**

Named for our mascot OMER, this award recognizes individuals or teams who demonstrate outstanding sportsmanship, exemplary behavior, or exceptional talent. Recipients may be anyone that officials feel exhibit these traits.

#### **About Odyssey of the Mind**

Odyssey of the Mind has its roots in the industrial design classes of Dr. Sam Micklus, the program's founder. As a professor at Rowan University in New Jersey (formerly Glassboro State College), Dr. Micklus challenged students to create vehicles without wheels, mechanical pie throwers, and flotation devices to travel across a lake. He evaluated them not on the success of their solutions, but on the ingenuity applied and the risk involved in trying something new and different.

Students had fun. Word spread. The students' activities attracted attention from the local media. Soon, people on the outside wanted a part of the action. This public interest led to the development of a creative problemsolving competition for school children: Odyssey of the Mind. Dr. Micklus still helps create new problems to this day.

#### **Scoring**

You'll see teams present their long-term solutions for a maximum of 200 points and 50 points for style. These problems were released in the fall.

During the day, teams also take part in spontaneous problems for up to 100 points. The teams don't know these problems in advance.

Scores for long-term (200), style (50), and spontaneous (100) are prorated against the other teams in each division. Scoring is finished after all teams are done competing.


#### Why Odyssey of the Mind is good for students

For over 40 years, Odyssey has taught students to learn creative problem-solving methods while having fun. By tapping into creativity and encouraging imaginative paths to problem-solving, students develop skills to solve problems – great and small – for a lifetime.

Odyssey teaches students how to think divergently by providing openended problems that appeal to a wide range of interests. Students learn how to identify challenges and think creatively to solve problems. They are free to express their ideas and suggestions without fear of criticism. The creative problem-solving process rewards thinking outside the box.

#### An international extravaganza

Odyssey is a worldwide competition, with teams from Argentina, Australia, Belarus, Canada, China, Germany, Greece, Hong Kong, Hungary, Japan, Kazakhstan, Lithuania, Mexico, Moldova, Poland, Singapore, Slovakia, South Korea, United Kingdom, Uzbekistan, and nearly every state across the USA. The annual World Finals is typically an event to behold. It embodies the international spirit of creativity!
