## JUMPSTART GRANT PROGRAM

### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### How do I apply?

The online application form is at [paodyssey.com/grants](http://paodyssey.com/grants).

#### Who is eligible?

- New memberships – Any school or community organization, such as a library, homeschool group, or church.
- Memberships that have not had a team compete at a regional tournament in the past four years.  
*If your membership competed in 2020 or earlier and have not since, you're eligible for the 2023-24 grants!*

#### What is the deadline?

The deadline to apply is **December 1, 2023**. Grant recipients are announced on a rolling basis as applications are received. The grants will be awarded at the discretion of **Creativity Unlimited in Pennsylvania (CUinPA)**, the 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that administers the Odyssey of the Mind program in our state. The total amount awarded is subject to change at the discretion of CUinPA.

#### What is covered by the grants?

- 1. Membership registration** with Creative Competitions, Inc. (one registration between \$190-290)  
*You'll need to register at [odysseyofthemind.com/join](http://odysseyofthemind.com/join), pay the fee, and send us a receipt for reimbursement.*
- 2. Regional tournament fees** (starting at \$100)  
*No action required! We'll waive your regional tournament fees. If you receive an invoice for regional tournament fees, send it to [grants@paodyssey.com](mailto:grants@paodyssey.com).*
- 3. Stipend for supplies and tools** (\$125 for each team)  
*After registering your teams, you'll receive the stipend(s) with the reimbursement for your membership registration*

#### What are the requirements to receive a payment for the grant?

Any teams covered by the grant must have a full seven (7) unique team members registered to receive a stipend. One child cannot be a part of more than one team covered by a grant.

#### What is not covered by the grants?

Any expenses not listed above will *not* be covered by a grant. Any accommodations and transportation to attend a tournament are *not* covered by a grant. If your team advances to World Finals, any fees or other costs for World Finals are *not* covered by a grant.

#### What other resources are provided to help a new team?

Each of our regions offers a free coaches' training in the fall, and we encourage you to attend! We'll also put you in touch with experienced Odyssey of the Mind volunteers in your area who are here to help.

#### How are the grants funded?

The grants are funded by generous donors, including alumni and friends of the PA Odyssey of the Mind community, to provide greater access to our creative problem-solving program. Thank you to our donors!
